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HCC Launches Community Resource Database, Creates Bilingual Web Site

(Lexington, MO – November 11, 2014) The Health Care Collaborative (HCC) of Rural Missouri has recently launched a community resource database that provides online access to contact information for health care providers, nonprofit organizations and social service agencies.

The Live Well Community Database, developed by a Lexington-based design firm, enables quick access to phone numbers, addresses and web sites. The tool is also outfitted for mobile devices and is searchable by county, service and agency. Although a work in progress, the database covers seven counties including: Carroll, Chariton, Johnson, Lafayette, Pettis, Ray and Saline.

HCC, which now owns and operates Live Well Community Health Center, Waverly, also launched a bilingual web site that caters to the migrant farmworker community. *LiveWellCenters.org* is the first bilingual web site in Lafayette County.

“As a health care provider and advocate for increasing access to care, it is important to us to consider all members of the community,” said HCC Executive Director Toniann Richard. “We believe that both the web site and the Live Well Community Database are viable resources that everyone can take advantage of. We welcome visitors to the site and encourage use of the database.”
