Raymore, MO: Pathways Community Health welcomes Raymore and the surrounding communities to join them for a groundbreaking ceremony for their new Raymore office located at 1020 Remington Plaza on Jan. 31, 2012 at 11:30 a.m.

The new facility, designed by architect Garen Miller, features a tele-med professional suite of nine offices for physicians and licensed specialists. In addition to bringing professionals to the Raymore community, the tele-med suite provides access to behavioral health specialists that may not currently be available in the community. It also allows Pathways to deliver specialized services across the state for individuals of all ages.

With over 8,988 square feet of space, and housing up to 60 staff, the new Raymore office space allows Pathways to continue to be a safety-net for those in need while also being the provider of choice in terms of quality behavioral health services. Pathways will be joining their Belton staff with the Raymore staff at the new location.

“Innovative and specialized service delivery and a focus on treating each individual as a whole person (factoring in both mental and physical health) make a difference in our quality of care,” said Linda Grgurich, Pathways Community Health President. “I am excited about this new space. We are incorporating a new way of thinking and doing business, like the tele-med suite, in our building/working design that will make a difference for our clients and staff and how they interact with each other,” said Grgurich.
