The Health Care Collaborative of Rural Missouri/Live Well Community Health Centers is excited to host a one-day public health service event for adults on Friday, May 21, 2021 from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. The event will be held at the Lexington 4-Life Center, 811 S Hwy 13 in Lexington MO. This event is for underserved and uninsured adults that need connected to various services in their community.

This year we are trying a different format to accommodate social distancing for COVID. All guests will have to pre-register ahead of time for a time of arrival for all services including dental. We will be utilizing the walking track at the Lexington 4-Life Center along with sidewalk in front of the building. We are limiting the number of service providers to the first 25 that return this form. You will need to bring your own table and chairs and your own hotspot for internet. **All service providers must wear a mask.**

Dental extractions (no cleanings) will be done at the Live Well Community Health Center onsite. There will also be free haircuts, various health screenings, vouchers for driver's licenses and birth certificates, manicures, photographs and more. We are inviting service providers such as your organization to be there to provide free services and disseminate information to guests connecting them to resources that day and raising awareness of what is available to them and others they know for future use.

All booths must be set-up by 8:00 am Friday morning and you **MUST STAY** until the event ends at **2:00 pm** that day. We anticipate 150+ guests to attend. We will help a LOT of people, meet many needs' and give a lot of hope!

Your organization is invited to participate by providing health information, informational/interactive booths, social services, health screenings OR any other service that can be delivered that day. Attached you will find a response sheet to return by email or fax. The first 25 organizations to return their form will be guaranteed a spot. Deadline to return your participation sheet is Wednesday, May 12 but spots will be assigned as the forms are returned!
